

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## About *Write Through the Bible*

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In 2012, while our family was memorizing Philippians 2:1-18, I was looking at what we were missing in our homeschool curriculum. I noted that I didn't have any handwriting or vocabulary work for our oldest son. I decided to create my own resource that would also help reinforce memorization of the Scripture we were working on.

If you choose to use this resource, it will integrate several subjects into one: handwriting, vocabulary, dictation, and memorization.

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It is very important for children to begin memory work from a young age. Scripture-memory, specifically, is vitally important. Using this resource is not a *primary* means of memorization but a secondary source to *reinforce* Bible memorization.

## **A Note About the Lord's Prayer**

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This workbook uses the version of the Lord's Prayer found Matthew 6:9-13. The translation is from *The Book of Common Prayer*, a version popular in many English-speaking churches today.

## **How to Use this Resource:**

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This resource is fully adaptable to your situation. If the selections are too long, shorten them. If the paper does not have the correct sized lines, use your own paper.

1. The first 3 days your child will copy the first part.
2. The next day your child will look up vocabulary words and write definitions.
3. The next day you will dictate the passage to your child to write out as you speak.
4. Then your child moves on to the next part of the Lord's Prayer. The pattern starts over again.
5. At the end your child will copy all the verses from the passage, writing out the entire Lord's Prayer. (This activity is broken up over several days.)

## **Tips:**

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1. Encourage your child to focus on neatness and using their very best handwriting.
2. Be sure to go over their work and praise them for good handwriting and correct where necessary.
3. There may be times your child needs help choosing the best definition to fit their vocabulary word. There are often many different choices, depending on the dictionary used. Give assistance where it is needed and help your child think through the possibilities.

1. The complete portion of Scripture being used in this resource, broken into the segments used throughout the book.
2. All vocabulary words with appropriate definitions (note, these are not the only definitions that can be used).

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**Below are all of the vocabulary words that are found throughout this workbook along with definitions. Please be aware, these are only possible definitions.**

Forgive: To stop feeling angry or resentful towards a person

Glory: Praise, worship, and high honor

Hallowed: Regarded as blessed and set apart

Kingdom: The region where a king reigns

Power: Great strength and might

Temptation: Something that entices you towards evil

Trespass: An offense, a sin


